Mary Pointer talked about cost of room and need to clean up and reset to get deposit back..

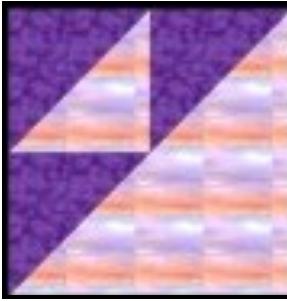
Shelly and Vickie presented Christmas in July program and discussed sending out 12 days of Christmas pattern.
