**New Business:**

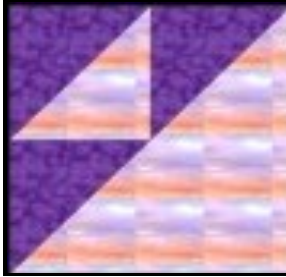

**Tami still has challenge fabric if interested.**

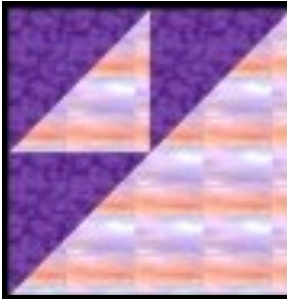
**Please bring more fabric for pillowcases.**

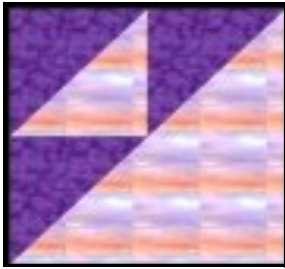

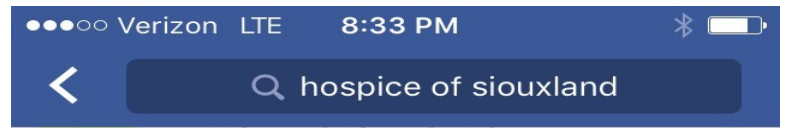

## LOOKING FOR SMALL RAFFLE TABLE ITEMS

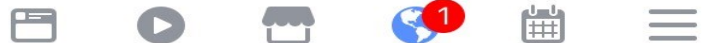
