Fons and Porter subscription is due 12/21, cost is \$20 and guild gets \$5.

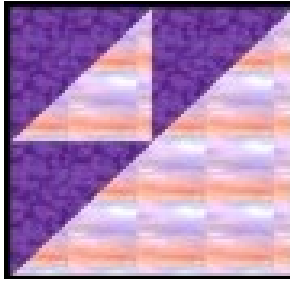
Lisa Beeson wasn't able to make it to quilt show, so if you won a ribbon and she quilted your quilt she requested pictures be taken for her.
